FORMAL GREETINGS

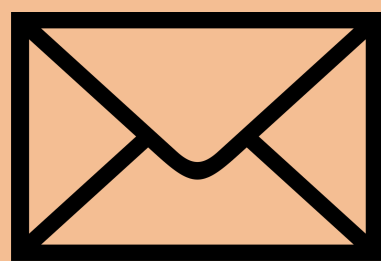
For when you meet new people:

For emails or written messages

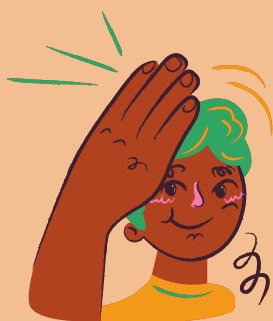
- Dear Sir / Madame + name
